

Competition Rules

1. Fishing Times 11.30 to 17.30 (Deadline back on the beach).
2. No limit to the number of rods used per angler minimum of two anglers per boat.
3. To be fished to VBC size limits.
4. The committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any boat not judged by the committee to be seaworthy or safe (trailers and winches must be suitable for beach launch & recovery)..
5. Safety Equipment to be on board during the competition.
A Life jacket or Buoyancy aid for each person taking part. A working compass. Distress Flares and VHF Radio.
6. An anchor and chain with at least 100 metres of rope.
7. Minimum Boat length 14ft, maximum length 19ft (hull length).
8. One fish can only win one prize.
9. No Tope to be weighed in.
10. Mackerel / Scad will only be eligible for inclusion in the most species prize.
11. The committee will not be held responsible for damage or injury to persons or property.
12. The committees decision on any issue is final.
